Plant Variety	Mature Height	Mature Width	Comments
Evergreen Varieties - Upright Arborvitae			
- Technito	8'+	4'-5'	Resists winter burn – can handle moist but not waterlogged soils
- Wintergreen	20'+	8'	Beautiful proportions and good winter burn resistance – fast growing
- DeGroot's Spire	6'-10'	2'-3'	Tight narrow form
- Holmstrup	8'-10'	2'-4'	Handles some shade well
- Rushmore	15'-20'	4'-6'	Resistant to winter burn
Upright Junipers	30'	15'	***All of the upright junipers need good drainage and PLENTY OF SUN
- Easter Red Cedar			
- Hetz Columnar	15'-18'	4'-6'	See above - ***
- Medora	12'-15'	4'-6'	See above - ***
- Taylor	8'-10'	4'-6'	See above - ***
- Wichita Blue	12'-15'	4'-6'	See above - ***
Pine and Spruce			
- Silver Whispers Stone Pine	12'	6'-8'	White Pine look with smaller size
- White Pine Fastigata (narrow)	10'-15'	10'-15'	Somewhat shade tolerant
- Upright Blue Spruce	15'+	7'-10'	Beautiful blue – avoid soggy ground
- Upright White Spruce	15'+	6'-10'	Tough tree - avoid soggy ground
- Norway Columnar Spruce	15'+	6'-8'	Rich deep green – disease resistant
- North Star White Spruce	8'+	5'+	A true dwarf
Narrow Form Deciduous Shrubs			
- Nannyberry Viburnum	15'-20'	6'-10'	Tolerates moist soil
- Arrowwood Viburnum	8'-12'	10'-12'	Cultivars – Burgundy & Autumn Jazz
- Rainbow Pillar Serviceberry	20'	8'-10'	Mildew resistant
- Standing Ovation Serviceberry	15'	4'-6'	Great new narrow plant – edible fruit
- Cardinal Red Twig Dogwood	8'-10'	8'-10'	Can tolerate moist soils – great winter red color
Narrower Deciduous Trees			
- Armstrong Maple	45'	15'	Good growth rates
- Conquest Norway Maple	40'	20'	Purple leaves in spring, changing to green with heat.
- Firefall Maple	45'	30'	Nice in-between width – fast grower – good red fall color – great tree from U of M
- Celebration Maple	40'-45'	20'-25'	Nice in between width – yellow/orange fall color – uniform shape
- Dakota Pinnacle Birch	30'	8'-10'	Tolerant of heat, high winds and clay soil. Resistant to birch borer.
- Street Keeper Honeylocust	45'	20'	Tolerates a wide variety of soil types
- Crimson Spire Oak	45'	15'	Red fall color – holds leaves for winter screening. This is an awesome tree – sure to be a hit!
- Regal Prince Oak	45'	18'	Lovely oval shape with little pruning
- Urban Pinnacle Bur Oak	55'	25'	Toughness of Bur Oak – much narrower crown
